Lodging: suites at Embassy Suites on 17th Street have been discounted to \$134 per night, with option to extend stay at that rate up to three nights before and/or three nights after the June 5-7 event. For those who wish to secure less expensive accommodations, please ask us to help you do so. If you live locally, we'd encourage you to renew a friendship and ask an out-of-area classmate to stay with you. For those of you within driving distance, see if you can travel with a nearby classmate.

Events: cost of the full two-night reunion, including full reception buffet on Friday and reception/dinner/deejay on Saturday has been trimmed to \$95. For those who wish to attend only Friday, cost is \$40; for Saturday only, it's \$65. Casual attire for both events.

Financial support: for those who are able and willing to contribute extra money, we will use it to subsidize costs and help those who can't otherwise afford to attend.
